ABOUT THIS QUILT

FABRICS BATIKS

TECHNIQUE PIECING

SKILL LEVEL ADVANCED BEGINNER

FINISHED SIZE 3 SIZES

36"x36" square table top,
35"x60"crib,
40"x56" lap

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Approximately 140 blocks can be made from a jelly roll

BATIK DARKS 2 1/2" STRIPS

BATIKS LIGHT 2 1/2" STRIPS

NEUTRALS 1 1/4 yd or 5 fat quarters

BINDING 3/8 YARD

MATERIALS

- 45 degree ruler (Dresden Plate)
- Basic sewing tools (i.e.. rotary cutter, 100% cotton thread, sewing machine, batting)

PREP THE FABRIC

FABRIC A & B

Cut 2 1/2" Strips if you are not using jelly roll strips.

FABRIC C

Cut 2 1/2" Strips, sub cut into 2 1/2" squares. You will need 2 for each block. Cut squares in half diagonally to make triangles. Used in Step 5.

SEWING

All seam allowances are 1/4" and pieces are sewn right sides together (RST).

STEPS

MAKING THE BLOCKS

Step 1 Place a dark strip (Fabric A) on top of a light strip (Fabric B) right sides together and cut triangles in multiples of 4 rotating the 45 degree Dresden template across the strips.

Step 2 Sew pairs of triangles together starting at wide end keeping the dark on top; press toward the dark.

Step 3 Sew 2 pairs together forming half blocks; press toward the dark.

Step 4 Sew halves together; press seams open.

Step 5 Sew corners onto light triangles (Fabric C), press seams towards corner.

Step 6 Trim blocks to 4 1/2'square.

ARRANGE THE BLOCKS

Arrange blocks or place randomly.

Sew blocks together in rows, then sew rows together.

Quilt as desired, Bind and enjoy!
