


HIS ROYAL

Number of Blocks and Finished Size 18 Union Jack Blocks 11" x 22"

Planning

Joyce's salute to all things British takes the classic Union Jack and, with the substitution of brown for red and the addition of a zippy binding color, gives it a sophisticated new spin. Each block is made with 1 navy, 1 cream/tan, and 1 brown batik. Fabric variations from block to block add depth and sparkle.

Knowledge of foundation piecing (paper piecing) is required for this pattern. For help with foundation piecing, visit McCallsQuilting.com and click on Lessons and then Foundation Piecing Primer.

Fabric Requirements

Assorted navy batiks 2³/₄-3 yds. (blocks) total Assorted cream/tan 31/2-33/4 yds. batiks (blocks) total Assorted brown 31/4-31/2 yds. batiks (blocks) total Bright yellow/green batik (binding) 3/4 yd.

43/8 yds.

76" x 76"

Cutting Instructions

(cut in order listed)

Backing

Batting size

Assorted navy batiks—cut 18 sets of: *4 matching rectangles 5" x 10" (Foundation Masters areas 1 and 5) Assorted cream/tan batiks—cut 18 matched

4 strips 2" x 111/2" (area 2) 4 strips 11/4" x 101/2"

4 strips 11/4" x 10" (area 4)

4 strips 11/4" x 41/4"


Assorted brown batiks-cut 18 matched sets of:

1 strip 21/2" x 111/2"

2 strips 21/2" x 101/2" 4 strips 13/4" x 11" (area 3)

Bright yellow/green batik


8 strips 21/2" x width of fabric (binding) *See Cutting Diagram, on next page.




Cutting Diagram

Piecing the Blocks

1 Note: The following instructions are for 1 block. Make 2 accurate copies each of Foundation Masters A and B. Referring to Foundation Masters and Cutting Instructions for patch placement, foundation piece 2 each A and B using matching fabrics (Diagram I). Trim excess paper and fabric from edges along outer dashed lines. Do not remove foundation papers until instructed.



2 Referring to Diagrams II-A and II-B, sew matching cream 41/4" and 101/2" strips to each A and B unit, watching placement.







Diagram II-B

3 Sew 2 vertical rows using 2 units and 1 matching brown 101/2" strip each (Diagram III). Sew vertical rows to brown 111/2" strip to make Union Jack Block. Repeat Steps 1 through 3 to make 18 total.



Assembling the Quilt Top

- 4 Referring to the Assembly Diagram, sew 6 rows of 3 blocks each. Sew rows together.
- **5** Stay-stitch a scant 1/4" inside raw edges. Remove foundation papers. Hint: If you have trouble removing foundation papers, lightly spray back of block with water and allow to rest for 10 minutes before removing papers. Test first using lightest block fabric to be sure water does not transfer foundation ink to fabrics.

Quilting and Finishing

6 Layer, baste, and quilt. Joyce machine quilted horizontal lines 3/8" apart in tan thread. Bind with bright yellow/green batik.
